

A Last-Minute Risk Assessment (LMRA) = One last check before starting and (re)starting work to avoid any accident



## PRE-START CHECKS USER GUIDE FOR SUBCONTRACTORS

### WHAT ARE THE PRE-START CHECKS?

- ✓ Pre-Start Checks are simplified Last Minute Risk Assessment
- ✓ Pre-Start Checks are last brief verification a worker shall perform each time he has about to start or restart an activity as there may be new risks.
- ✓ Pre-Start Checks shall be done to ensure that key prevention and protection measures have been implemented to avoid any injury.

#### For who ?

You must perform the Pre-Start Checks if you:

- ✓ Are a craftsman working in a small company (<10 employees)
- ✓ Work for or on behalf of the Group
- ✓ Do not work on ENGIE sites in Operation or under construction
- ✓ Work at customers' premises (individuals or Companies)
- ✓ You never have the opportunity to take part in safety visits, inspections from ENGIE

#### The objective of the Pre-Start Checks

Help you to:

- ✓ Identify the risks to which you are exposed
- ✓ Adopt the right behaviors with regard to the personal protective equipment to be worn, the equipment and tools to be used, etc.

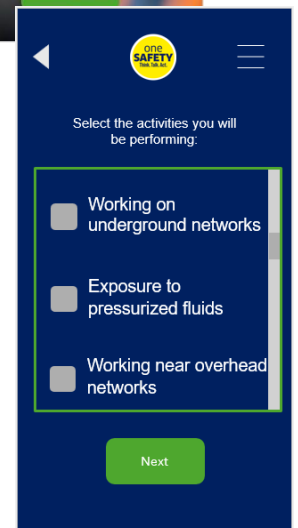
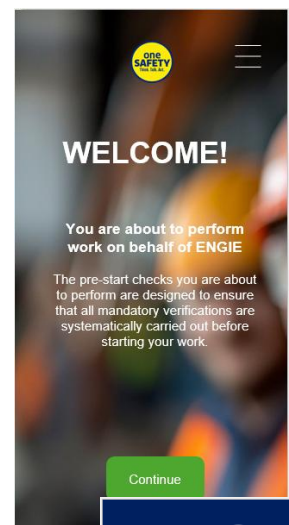
#### When exactly to perform the Pre-Start Checks ?

✓ You must perform your Pre-Start Checks every time in your activity, your are exposed to the following high risks:

#### What if there is no exposure to any of these risks?

✓ You simply declare on the form that the day's work does not involve any of these risks.

## ABOUT THE PRE START CHECKS AND ITS MEMO SHEETS

- Twelve control sheets related to activities exposed to high risks
- In each control sheets, four to five control to perform for each job when working on behalf of ENGIE
- Eleven practical sheets giving additional prevention and protection means to subcontractors

## HOW TO PERFORM YOUR PRE START CHECKS

1. Go to ENGIE One Safety website - [One Safety - Home](#)
2. Enter the generic access code communicated by the ENGIE company which hired you
3. Read the instruction
4. Complete the authentication form with your information
5. Select your activity of the day from the drop-down list.
6. Do the checks for each risks on which your activity is exposed
7. Consult the practical Memo sheets, if needed, to get additional prevention measures
8. Exit the Pre-Start Checks application
